## **GRIID Annual Research Day -2025**

The Government Rehabilitation Institute for Intellectual Disabilities (GRIID), Sector 31c, Chandigarh, successfully organized its 5th Annual Research Day on March 24, 2025, marking a significant occasion in honour of the birth anniversary of the late Prof. B.S. Chavan, former Director of the Institute and a pioneer in the field of disability rehabilitation. The event served as a platform for knowledge exchange and academic enrichment, attracting over 100 professionals, research scholars, and students from various institutions across Chandigarh, Panjab University, and neighbouring states.

The theme for this year's Research Day was "**Building Capacity in Inclusion for Children with Special Needs,**" highlighting the significance of inclusive education and service delivery for children with intellectual and developmental disabilities. The inaugural session began with the lighting of the ceremonial lamp, followed by Saraswati Vandana, which symbolises the pursuit of knowledge and wisdom.



The program was honoured by Prof. A.K. Attri, Director-Principal of GMCH and Director of GRIID, who served as the Chief Guest, along with other dignitaries, including Dr. Ajeet Sidana, Joint Director, Dr. M.
