

M.ED. SPECIAL EDUCATION (Intellectual Disability)
(SESSION 2019-21 as per RCI/ Panjab University Rules)**

Govt. Rehabilitation Institute for Intellectual Disabilities (GRIID), Sector -31, Chandigarh invites applications from eligible candidates for admission to M.Ed. Special Education (Intellectual Disability) (2 years Course) for the session 2019-21, who have successfully completed B.Ed. Spl. Edu. (Intellectual Disability) or its equivalent qualification recognized by RCI, New Delhi. The application proforma alongwith other information can be downloaded from our website i.e. www.griid.edu.in from 1st August, , 2019. The candidate should submit their application form completed in all respect alongwith testimonials upto 4:00pm on or before 13th August, 2019 (Tuesday).

i) The eligibility criteria for the admission M.Ed. SE-MR Course for the session 2019-21 is as under: -

As per prospectus, the admission for the degree of M.Ed. Special Education (Intellectual Disability) shall be open to candidates who have scored at least 50% marks (45% in case of SC/ST) and possess the following qualification:

- A candidate who has successfully passed B.Ed. Special Education (Mental Retardation/Intellectual Disability) from a recognized University or any other Degree from a recognized University and considered equivalent to B.Ed. Special Education (MR/ID) by Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI).

OR

- A candidate who has successfully passed the B.Ed. (General) course and has completed Diploma in Education, Special Education (MR/ID), a PG Professional Diploma in Special Education (MR/ID) PGPDSE (MR) recognized by the Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI) till academic session 2014-15.
- A candidates with B.Ed in particular specialization may be allowed for M.Ed. cross disability/ multi category (as and when offered) but the reverse is not allowed. B.Ed with multi-category should not be admitted for specialization in a single disability at the M.Ed. level, however; as a part of CBCS, these can be admitted to B.Ed Special Education Area C courses and complete the specialization courses to qualify for a particular disability. On completion of Area C, these can be admitted to the M.Ed Spl.Edu. in a specific disability

OR

- A student with B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. B.Ed.Spl.Ed. (4 years Integrated)

OR

A student who have done BRS with specialization in special education in MR

Note: * UT Pool 01 seat reserved for Ex-serviceman, Dependents of Defence/

Paramilitary Personnel etc., Freedom Fighter and Physical Handicapped (whichever merit is higher) will be given.

** Non-UT Pool 01 seat is reserved SC/ST (whichever merit is higher) will be given.

*** Non –UT Pool 01 seat is reserved for Ex-serviceman, Dependents of Defence/ Paramilitary Personnel etc., Freedom Fighter and Physical Handicapped (whichever merit is higher) will be given.

As per reservation policy for Chandigarh Colleges:

A. 60% seats will be filled up from amongst the student who passed their qualifying examination from colleges recognized by the Chandigarh Administration and situated in the Union Territory of Chandigarh as a regular student of the said Colleges/Institutions, subject to the condition that such students must have studied for two years at Chandigarh and have passed one lower qualifying examination from the local colleges/ institutions. These seats will be termed as 'UT Pool'.

B. General Pool 40%: Out of the total sanctioned intake of the institutions 40% seats will be filled from amongst the students who pass their qualifying examination from the institutions other than those located in the Union Territory of Chandigarh. These seats will be termed as 'General Pool'. Students who have passed their qualifying examination through distance mode will be considered in General pool only.

Reservation:

Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes

The following percentage of seats is prescribed for the students belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes:

U.T. Pool: -

Scheduled Caste – 15%

Scheduled Tribes – NIL

General Pool: -

Scheduled Caste – 15%

Scheduled Tribes – 05%

If the requisite number of students of SC category in the UT Pool is not available, the seats will be made open to the students belonging to General category of the said pool. If the requisite number of students belonging to SC/ST categories are not available, the reservation will be interchangeable amongst the students of these communities. However, if the seats still remain unfilled, these will be made open amongst the students of the General category of the said-pool.

- Note: - i) The counselling to admission in M.Ed. Special Education (MR/ID) Course for the session 2019-21 will be held in the O/o Director, GRIID, Room No. 210, GMCH, Sector 31, Chandigarh.
- ii) The candidates must bring the original documents from Class 10th onwards alongwith DMC, Migration & Degree.
- iii) The candidates who have opted for NCC /NSS must bring their original certificate.

- iv) The candidates must bring a self-attested copy of all above mentioned testimonials & certificate.

RESERVATION POLICY FOR CHANDIGARH COLLEGES: -

A candidate applying in the Reserved Categories shall carefully indicate his/her claim **for only one category in the Admission Form**. In case the candidate wrongly indicates claim for more than one reserved categories, the one claimed in the first instance shall be considered. No change of category will be entertained/permitted in the application form or otherwise at a later stage.

A. UT Pool 60%: Sixty percent seats of the total sanctioned intake of the Institution will be filled up from amongst the students who pass their qualifying examination from Colleges recognized by the Chandigarh Administration and situated in the Union Territory of Chandigarh as a regular students of the said College/Institute subject to the condition that such students must have studied **for at least two years at Chandigarh and have passed one lower qualifying examination from the these colleges/ Institutions. These seats will be termed as 'UT Pool'**.

B. General Pool 40%: Forty percent seats of the total sanctioned intake of the institution will be filled up from amongst the students who pass their qualifying examination from the institutions other than those located in the Union Territory of Chandigarh. These seats will be termed as 'General Pool'. Students who have passed their qualifying examination through distance mode will be considered in General pool only.

Reservation:

Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes

The following percentage of seats is prescribed for the students belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes:

U.T. Pool:

Scheduled Caste – 15%
Scheduled Tribes – NIL

General Pool:

Scheduled Caste – 15%
Scheduled Tribes – 05%

If the requisite number of students of SC category in the UT Pool is not available, the seats will be made open to the students belonging to General category of the said pool. If the requisite number of students belonging to SC/ST categories are not available, the reservation will be interchangeable amongst the students of these communities. However, if the seats still remain unfilled, these will be made open amongst the students of the General category of the said-pool.

Ex-Serviceman, Dependents of Defence/ Para-Military Personnel etc:

5% of the seats in each pool would be filled in from the following categories of students in order of preference:

- (a) Sons/ daughters/spouses of the defence personnel who are awardees of gallantry decorations of Paramvir / Mahavir / Vir Chakra in person or posthumously **OR** Sons/ daughters/spouses of the defence personnel and Para-military personnel like CRPF, BSF etc. who are killed or are totally incapacitated in action while in service and were wholly dependent on them.
- (b) Sons/daughters/spouses of the defence and Para-military personnel like CRPF, BSF etc. who died while in service and were wholly dependent on them.

- (c) Sons/daughters/spouses of the defence and Para-military personnel like CRPF, BSF etc. incapacitated while in service and were wholly dependent on them.
- (d) Sons/daughters/spouses of ex-serviceman (defence and Para-military personnel like CRPF, BSF etc.) that are wholly dependent on them.
- (e) Sons/daughters/spouses of serving defence and Para-military personnel like CRPF, BSF etc. who are wholly dependent on them.

Note:

- i) The applicants seeking admission under categories (a) are required to submit the photocopy of citation for gallantry award, failing which they will not be considered for this category.
- ii) The applicants under category (b) and (c) are required to submit the certificate from the respective headquarters regarding death or total incapacitation while in service.
- iii) The applicants seeking admission to category (d) are required to submit discharge certificate from service and certificate of dependence from the Director Zila Sainik Board.
- iv) The applicants claiming admission under category (e) are required to submit the certificate of dependence from the unit in which parent/spouse is serving.

Persons with Disability (PwD)

5% seats are reserved for differently abled/physically challenged persons, according to the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016. The Physically challenged student will be required to furnish a medical certificate issued by the Principal Medical Officer of his concerned district/Civil Surgeon of Chandigarh, indicating percentage of disability, whether he/she is otherwise able to pursue his/her studies, name of the disease/handicap, whether the handicap is temporary or permanent; and whether the 40% handicap is progressively degenerative.

5% marks concession will be given to physically handicapped persons in the minimum eligibility criteria for a course subject to minimum disability of 40% provided they have obtained minimum pass marks prescribed by regulation.

Student with a temporary handicap will not be considered against the reserved seats for physically challenged. Where the certificate is issued by any authority other than the Principal Medical Officer of Chandigarh, the concerned Head of the Institution shall refer the candidate to the Principal Medical Officer, Chandigarh and shall admit the candidate only after confirmation from the PMO, Chandigarh.

All candidates seeking admission will furnish an undertaking, as under, alongwith their application form: **I certify that I have no such physical handicap/disability which would hinder the pursuit of studies in the course in which I am seeking admission. If at a later stage it is found that I have a physically handicap/disability which hinders the pursuit of studies in the course in which I am seeking admission, then my admission will be liable to be cancelled.**

In case of any doubt in interpretation of any clause of these instruction, the matter shall be referred to the Chandigarh Administration whose decision shall be final.

Children and Grandchildren of Freedom Fighters

Two per cent (2%) seats from each pool will be filled from the children and grandchildren of freedom fighters.

- (a) A freedom fighter is a person who has either been granted freedom fighter pension by the Chandigarh Administration or has been awarded "Tamra Patra" by Government of India for his political sufferings. No

person other than the above mentioned persons will be considered as freedom fighter for the purpose of reservation in admission. The requisite certificate will be issued by the Deputy Commissioner, Chandigarh, which will be considered irrespective of the form in which it is issued, provided it is self-explanatory.

- (b) Grand children mean son's sons/daughters or daughter's sons/ daughters.
- (c) The wards of freedom fighters who have been awarded "Tamra Patras" by the Government of India would also be eligible for reservation under this category. In the case of such freedom fighters they should produce their "Tamra Patras" certificate, freedom fighter certificate and dependence certificate from the Deputy Commissioner of the district in which they reside.

Note: - The applicants from this category will not be considered without the following documents:

- i) The photocopy of "Tamra Patra" certificate or freedom fighter certificate.
- ii) Dependence certificate from the concerned Deputy Commissioner.

The reservation policy and seats as given above shall be strictly adhered to. In case seats in a Reserved category remain vacant on account of non-availability of qualified candidates such seats may be filled up from the General category. The candidate who had applied for a Reserved category will be considered for that particular category/categories only.

This reservation is in accordance to the Home Policy of Chandigarh Administration, Chandigarh.

Note: - As and when there is a change in the Home Policy or University rules, it will be incorporated in the admission policy and intimated to the students and displayed on the notice board also.

The Complete set of documents to be submitted will include following documents: -

- 1) Hard copy of duly filled up admission form
- 2) Copy of Mark-sheet of qualifying examination (B.Ed. or equivalent examination))
- 3) Copy of Matriculation certificate for proof of date of birth
- 4) Copy/ copies of certificate for claiming seat against reserved category (if any)
- 5) Copy of Certificate/s supporting the claims for the weightages (as per guidelines)
- 6) Certificate/s for claiming seat against UT pool as per Sub appendices A1 & A2.
- 7) Affidavit for gap year, if any.
- 8) The counselling to admission in M.Ed. Special Education (Mental Retardation/Intellectual Disability) Course for the session 2019-21 will be held in the O/o Director, GRIID, Room No. 210, GMCH, Sector 32, Chandigarh.

Note: - 1. All the Candidates are directed to appear for 1st Counselling on 20.08.2019 at 3:00 PM in the O/o Director GRIID at Govt. Medical College & Hospital (Hospital Building), Sector 32, Chandigarh in Room No. 210, Block 'D', Chandigarh.
